



## Energy & Environmental Policy Statement

Martin-Brower UK and Ireland operates a food (frozen, chilled & ambient) and non-food end to end supply chain solutions service. It is our intention to provide a distribution and collection service which meets or exceeds the expectations of all our customers.

We are a socially responsible company and as such are committed to conducting our business with a sound and sustainable energy and environmental strategy.

As evidence of our commitment to sustainability we operate an effective Energy and Environmental Management System (EnEMS) which is appropriate to the nature and scale of our business in regard to the environmental impacts of our activities, products and services. Through the EnEMS the relevant legislative requirements will be met and all compliance and other obligations in relation to our environmental aspects and energy efficiency, usage and consumption will be fulfilled.

The EnEMS is externally certified to the following internationally recognised standards:

- BS EN ISO 14001:2015
- BS EN ISO 50001:2018

We have a Science Based Target (SBTi) to halve absolute carbon emissions by 2030 on 2018 levels; and reach net zero carbon emissions by 2040.

Our ambitions to limit our impact on climate change and to drive circularity within our supply chain continue to develop. Currently realised through our collection of used cooking oil from our customer for conversion into biodiesel for use in our logistics fleet, with sustainability for this process certified by the:

- International Sustainability & Carbon Certification

Through a policy of continual improvement we have developed objectives and targets to enhance our energy and environmental performance and our EnEMS, with focus on:

1. Applying the Waste Hierarchy as priority to achieve zero waste to landfill at all locations;
2. Prudently and sustainably using natural resources, raw materials, water and packaging;
3. Ensuring efficient energy use and eliminating energy waste;
4. Minimising reliance on fossil fuels where possible and investigating alternative sustainable sources of energy;
5. Supporting the purchase of energy-efficient products and services, and design for energy performance improvement.
